

# 2022 Kansas Fights Flu Collegiate Flu Challenge Summary

The Collegiate Flu Challenge is a campaign partnership of The Immunize Kansas Coalition, Kansas Healthcare Collaborative, and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment along with colleges and universities to raise awareness of the importance of influenza immunization and increase vaccination among students across campuses in Kansas. The 2022-2023 flu season was the inaugural year of this challenge in Kansas. Students that were vaccinated for flu were asked to scan a QR code and complete a short survey. Identifying information was not collected in the survey; the surveys collected self-reported information, and the honor system was used. Rates for each campus were calculated based on students that completed the survey.

7 different college campuses participated

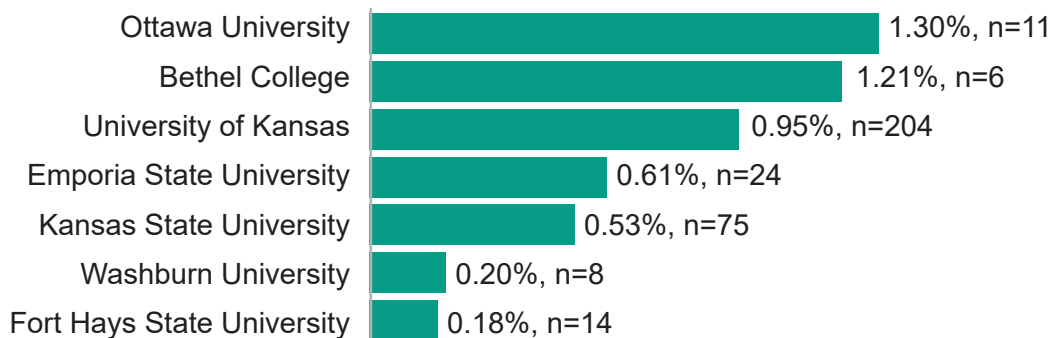


345 students completed the survey

Ottawa University had the highest percentage of students complete a survey post flu vaccination

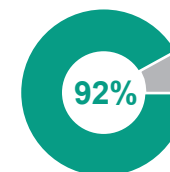


65% of students were female

## Vaccination Insights Among Students Completing the Survey



4 out of 5 respondents reported receiving a flu shot last year

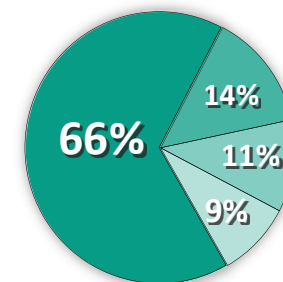


Of the 345 students that responded to the survey 92% indicated they were not hesitant about receiving their vaccination



4 out of 5 (79%) of male respondents reported receiving a flu shot last year

### Student Program Response



66% of students that responded were in the Bachelors program, 14% in Doctorate, 11% Masters and 9% indicated other



6 out of 7 (87%) of female respondents reported receiving a flu shot last year
