Protecting Kansas with Immunization



What is the purpose of a vaccine for a vaccine-preventable disease?

It teaches the immune system to recognize the disease, while the immune system is rapidly learning early in its life.



Example: We don't wait until high school to teach math; learning to recognize numbers starts early in life



Why do we give vaccines?



To reduce preventable diseases and their harmful side effects (For example: Measles, polio, pertussis)

To protect populations who can't receive vaccinations

Why are vaccines recommended at the ages they are?

To teach the immune system at the point it is most trainable



Some pieces of training require multiple lessons (immunizations)

When it comes to childhood immunizations, state law in Kansas requires certain immunizations for childcare and school attendance.
